Grainger County Commission:

The Grainger County Parks and Recreation Department would like to provide you with a department report covering through May 31, 2024.

Three-Star Grant Award

We are currently still awaiting TVA approval for the Land Use Permit application. Once approval is final, work can begin on constructing the outdoor stage at Grainger County Park. I plan to meet with our TVA Representatives Thursday, June 6th to discuss status.

Food Truck Friday Events

We partnered this year with the Grainger County Chamber of Commerce for the 2nd Annual Food Truck Friday Event at Grainger County Park. The first event this season was held on Friday, April 26, 2024 and was a huge success even with bad weather. The next Food Truck Friday event will be held on Friday, May 31st and then again on Friday June 28th. The event time has been updated to 5:00pm-8:30pm. Not only do we have multiple food vendors scheduled for each month but we have live music, cornhole, and horseshoes available for the public to take part in. We will continue the event through the month of September 2024.

2024 RTP Grant

Applications were submitted to TDEC for the 2024 RTP Grant for trail extension at Grainger County Park. If awarded this grant would be for a total of \$490,000. Since this is a 80/20 match type grant, the County's portion would be \$98,000 with \$392,000 coming from TDEC. The funding would be used for paved walking trail extension along with parking lot repairs and ADA parking at the boat ramp area.

2024 Healthy Built Grant

Applications have also been submitted for the Healthy Built Environment Grant. The full application is due this month and will be for playground equipment to be installed in Washburn at the Ball Fields and Community Center Complex. If awarded this grant will require no match and be funded up to \$80,000 for the playground project.

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE INCENTIVE (BONUS) COMPENSATION

WHEREAS, Emergency Medical Services are a vital public service; and

WHEREAS, the members of emergency medical service teams are ready to provide care to those in need twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week and should be compensated accordingly;

WHEREAS, part of the legislative body intent is to provide bonus incentives to members of the emergency medical service employees to assist with employee retention; and

WHEREAS, Grainger County appreciates the service provided by members of the emergency medical service employees and wishes to establish an incentive bonus plan whereby members of the team may be compensated for certain revenue goals being met;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Legislative Body of Grainger County Tennessee establishes the compensation guidelines for members of the emergency medical service team as follows:

1. Members of the emergency medical services team will be compensated an incentive bonus when patient charges (41320) revenue exceeds \$1,000,000.00 for the fiscal year. Incentive bonus funding shall not exceed \$100,000 per fiscal year.
2. Emergency medical service personnel will receive the Incentive bonus as outlined in the attached "Exhibit A".
3. The amounts received will be public record.
4. Incentive bonus resolutions must be approved by County Legislative Body at the beginning of each fiscal year.

This Incentive bonus resolution is effective for fiscal year 2024-25.

To qualify for full bonus compensation, each of the employees must have been an employee in good standing with the department of EMS for the entire 12 months of the fiscal year.

If a person has worked a portion of the fiscal year in good standing as a full-time employee with the department of EMS, then that employee shall receive a prorated compensated bonus in the amount calculated by the number of uninterrupted whole months.
